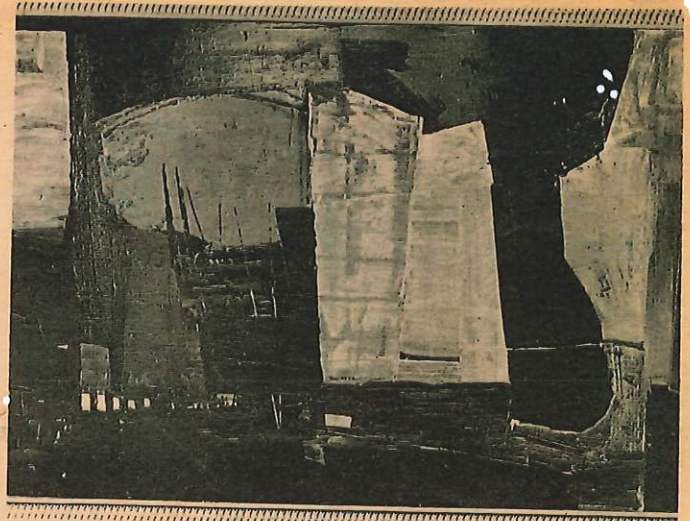




Bodegon Obycuro by Rafael Rivera Garcia

7 Artists

SEVEN artists have joined together to exhibit at the University of Puerto Rico Museum. The show will consist of paintings—by John Balossi, Felix Bonilla Norat, Alfredo Cubina, Rolando Lopez Dirube, Antonio Molina, Jeanne Pasley and Rafael Rivera Garcia—and two sculptures by Balossi.

Balossi, who is director of the UPR Extension Division Gallery and a professor of fine arts at the university, has had 10 one man shows in San Juan and New York. After this show he will exhibit in Paris and New York.

Bonilla, who was born in Cayey, has studied art in Boston and Florence. While with the U.S. Army in Paris he assisted in reintegrating the Louvre collection. A UPR fine arts professor, he has exhibited in seven countries.

Lopez Dirube, a native of Cuba, is sculptor, painter, printmaker and muralist with 70 murals to his credit in Cuba and 20 in Puerto Rico. He has studied in Havana, Madrid and New York and exhibited in Europe and the United States.

Cubina, a former pupil of Lopez

Dirube, was born in Cuba. In Puerto Rico he has exhibited at the Ateneo Puertorriqueno, the Institute of Puerto Rican Culture, the University of Puerto Rico Museum and the Ponce Museum of Art.

Molina, also a native of Cuba, has lived in Puerto Rico for five years. A specialist in monoprints, he has exhibited in Havana, San Juan, Ponce, Washington, Miami, New York, Bonn, Rome, Caracas, Switzerland and Canada.

Jeanne Pasley who was born in New Jersey, studied at the Art Students League. She has exhibited in New Jersey, New York and Puerto Rico. She holds first prize from the New Jersey State Exhibit of 1963.

Rivera Garcia, who is now studying for his doctorate at the University of Miami, is on sabbatical from the University of Puerto Rico where he is a professor of fine arts. The former director of the Extension Division Museum and assistant director of the university Museum, he has held numerous exhibitions in Puerto Rico, New York and Miami.



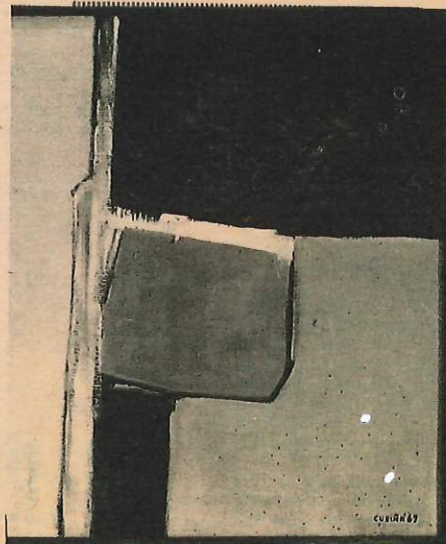
