Borinquen 12

THE INSTITUTE OF PUERTO RICAN CULTURE is currently exhibiting 66 works belonging to members of "Grupo de Artes Plasticas Borinquen 12." This show, at the institute's main exhibit hall, will be on view until July 27.

Borinquen 12 is a cooperative founded in the autumn of 1968, consisting of painters and sculptors. Its headquarters and show-rooms were first located on San Jorge Street, in San-turce. Later the group had "tertulias" on different topics concerning art and

the art world at "La Mansion." there they also exhibited their works either collectively or individually, like Felix Bonilla Norat's recent one-man show. Bonilla Norat is President of Borinquen 12; Antonio J. Molina, art critic of "El Mundo" and painter is secretary, and Rafael Rivera Garcia is treasurer.

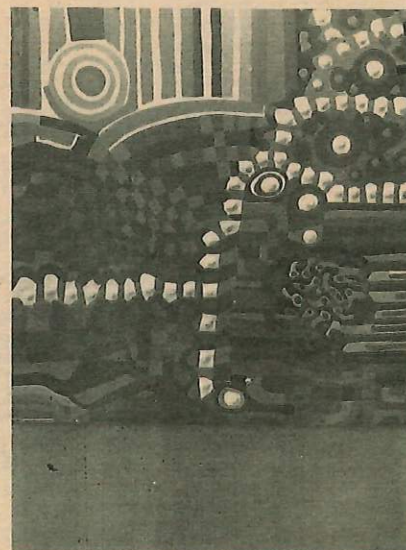
